ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to fully paid members of the Vintage Motor Cycle Club Ltd and invited single make motor cycle clubs. Membership number must be quoted on the entry form and be produced at the start of the event when signing on.

ENTRIES

Entries on the official form accompanied by the correct entry fee of £10.00 will be accepted forthwith. Closing date for entries is the 29th of June 2009. No late entries will be accepted. The entry limit is 100.

DESCRIPTION

The event will start and finish at Stony Stratford, Milton Keynes. Refreshments will be provided at the start of the day. We will stop at Redbourn for lunch. The afternoon run will conclude with refreshments and the awarding of prizes.

The route will cover a maximum distance of 100 miles, including some steep hills, on surfaced roads. There will be a short route option for those riding veteran machines. Riders will be observed for correct machine handling, road safety, and may be required to answer questions or undertake special tests on route. All machines must be at least 25 years old and Veterans are especially welcomed.

Post Veteran machines must be of totally British manufacture. The organisers invite entries from ACU affiliated Single Make clubs, the number of non V.M.C.C. members competing will be limited to a maximum of approximately 25% of the entry.

If a passenger is to be carried, the machine must be fitted with a properly mounted seat and footrests. These should also be fitted to suit the age of the passenger carried.
